

OṢELINOX POLICY

ON THE PREVENTION OF MAJOR ACCIDENTS, caused by dangerous substances according to SEVESO III Directive

Operation of the work equipment and facilities in safe conditions and continuous care to reduce the risks of a major accident caused by the storage and handling of dangerous substances, located on the company's site, are among our priorities!

OṢELINOX permanently applies measures to maintain safety in operating for achieving the following specific **objectives**:

- **Promoting a safe working environment, preventing any incident / accident** related on site activities under normal and abnormal operating and technological risk, adoption and **implementation of Quality, Environment, Occupational Health & Safety standards**;
- Carrying out activities **in compliance with rules** about: environmental protection, monitoring of the environmental factors, occupational health and safety of workers and the use of applied technologies;
- **Training of all personnel** in order to know and to be aware about the environmental risks and safety in operating for each one involved activity.

For achieving these objectives, OṢELINOX has adopted the following **principles for action on the control of major accident hazards**:

- **Comply with safety standards and organizing activities under minimal risk conditions** for safety in operation of facilities, processes and equipment;
- **Ensuring the organizational framework, human resources and materials** necessary for to carry out the activity in optimal conditions;
- **Clear assignment of responsibilities** for identification, assessment, prevention and control of major accident hazard;
- Training and awareness of personnel, including the subcontractors and external suppliers, about the importance of **measures for preventing the occurrence of causes that can lead to a major accident**;
- **Orientation towards the most modern and the safest technologies** applicable in the Company processes;
- **Planning the approach for emergency situation and communication activities** to authorities and public, **in the shortest possible time**, in case of occurrence of a major accident.

By monitoring and measuring the established objectives, auditing activities that could generate major accidents, the **Top Management is committed to ensure the resources necessary for adoption of safety measures** according to Romanian Law 59/2016 (Directive 2012/18/EU), Security Report and Internal Emergency Plan.
